Dear Commercial Solid Waste Hauler:

On February 27, 2007 a new City ordinance regulating commercial solid waste collection service was adopted. There are a few basic purposes for this ordinance:

- To establish minimum standards for commercial solid waste collection and compliance of the same.
- To compensate the City for the wear and tear on City streets resulting from the collection and transportation of commercial solid waste in the City.

The Municipal Services Department is responsible for administering this new ordinance, which requires that all property owners using these types of services use franchised haulers only.

The Ordinance took effect on April 1, 2007. The accompanying documentation contains the procedures and the form to be used to apply for a non-exclusive Commercial Solid Waste Collection Services franchise agreement in order to comply with this ordinance. It is important that you complete and submit the application form along with other required information as soon as possible so that we can issue your franchise and ensure uninterrupted collection services. Forms will also be available at the City of Boca Raton Building Department permit counter located on the first floor of City Hall, 201 W. Palmetto Park Road, Boca Raton, FL 33432.
