

**CITY OF BOCA RATON
PROPOSED FY 2015-16 to 2019-20 CONSOLIDATED PLAN
AND FY 2015-16 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
WITH FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM**

Pursuant to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) 24 CFR Part 91, et al, Consolidated Submission for Community Planning and Development Programs, it is required that the City of Boca Raton submit a five year Consolidated Plan, to include an annual Action Plan. The Action Plan portion consists of a description of all activities that will be undertaken in FY 2015-16 (10/1/15 through 9/30/16) to address priority needs identified in the 2015-16 to 2019-20 Five Year Consolidated Plan. The 2015-16 CDBG entitlement allocation is \$431,088, subject to final HUD appropriation.

Notice of Plan Availability and Public Hearing

It is also required that the City of Boca Raton, before City Council adoption of the 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan, make the Plan available to citizens, agencies, and other interested parties for their review and comment. At least 30 days must be allowed to receive these comments and they should be considered in the preparation of the final Plan.

In compliance with the above requirement, the City of Boca Raton hereby informs the community that the 2015-2020 Five Year Consolidated Plan and the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing will be available at the Community Improvement Division/Development Services Department, Room 220, City Hall, 201 W. Palmetto Park Rd., Boca Raton, FL 33432, from May 27, 2015 to June 26, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekdays, telephone 561-393-7797 (561-367-7043 for the hearing impaired).

An additional opportunity to comment on the Consolidated Plan will be provided at a public hearing to be held at 5:00 p.m. Thursday, June 11, 2015 in the First Floor Conference Room, Boca Raton City Hall, at the above address. Written comments are encouraged and may be submitted at the hearing or mailed to the address listed above by no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 26, 2015.
